



Mark Marquess

Head Coach
University of Stanford

- Coach Marquess begins his 31st year as Head Coach at Stanford
- He captured back to back World Series titles in 1987 and 1988.
- Stanford has qualified for the NCAA Regionals 24 times in the last 26 campaigns
- Mark has been the NCAA Coach of the year 3 times.
- As coach of the 1988 U.S. Olympic team, he guided them to a gold medal



Fred Corral

Pitching Coach
University of Tennessee

- He is regarded as one of the most respected pitching coaches in the country
- In his 16 year coaching career 51 pitchers have been MLB draftees
- He has worked in the professional ranks with the Expos and Dodgers
- Corral has produced 3 outstanding video tapes about pitching
- His pitching philosophy and methods to teach pitching will be explored during the 2009 Bash.



Joe Raccuia

Head Coach
Radford University

- Raccuia was appointed Head Coach at Radford on July 10, 2007
- In his first season the Highlanders posted 24 wins, the most since 2000
- Joe served as the hitting instructor for the University of Alabama for 2 years
- After graduating from Radford, his coaching career began in 1996
- In 2005 he was Coach of the year in the MAAC, while leading Marist U. to the NCAA regionals



Kevin Anderson

Head Baseball Coach
Shenandoah University

- Introduced as Shenandoah U. head baseball coach in 2003, Kevin has brought the program to new heights
- In 2007 he led the Hornets to 27 wins, second best in school history
- During his 9 years in the college ranks he has posted 265 wins
- From 1994 to 1997 he was the Head Coach at James Madison University
- Anderson has also coached in the Valley League.



John Cohen

Head Coach
Mississippi State University

- June 7, 2008 Cohen returned to his Alma Mater as the Head Baseball Coach
- Cohen won 175 games at the University of Kentucky and became their winningest Coach in their baseball history
- In 2006 he was the National Coach of the year
- John is regarded as one of the top hitting instructors in the college ranks
- In the last 3 years he has had fifteen players drafted by MLB



Erik Bakich

Assistant Coach
Vanderbilt

- Erik is in his seventh year as Vanderbilt recruiting coordinator and hitting coach
- The Commodores have led the SEC in hitting the last 3 years under his direction
- He is also a certified strength and conditioning coach
- Coach Corbin states that Bakich is one of the best at what he does
- Coach Bakich will share the secrets of Vandy's high power offense



Chris McKnight

Former Head Coach
Frostburg State University

- Chris has coached in the college ranks for 18 years. He completed his final season in 2008 at Frostburg State.
- He now directs the Baseball Vision Program.
- His program is used at the TPX 96 College
- Coaches clinics across the nation.
- While at Frostburg his teams were always ranked in most offensive categories
- His program is used by many college programs and also by the Orioles, Rangers and Brewers



Ryan Wheeler

Assistant Coach
University of Richmond

- Wheeler is entering his 3rd year as recruiting coordinator and hitting coach at UR
- He also coached 1 year at Penn and 9 years at William and Mary
- During his coaching career, he has had fifteen players taken in the MLB draft.
- Ryan was a 31st round draft pick of the California Angels
- In 2001 Wheeler helped guide William and Mary to a school record in wins



Spanky McFarland

Head Coach
James Madison University

- 2009 will mark the 11th year for McFarland as Head Coach at JMU
- During McFarland's tenure twenty-six players have signed professional contracts
- McFarland has coached 61 pitchers who played professionally
- As an author he has penned two books, "Developing Pitchers" and "Coaching Pitchers"
- Spanky has done clinics around the country and also in Scotland, Austria and Slovakia



Marlin Ikenberry

Head Coach
Virginia Military Institute

- He begins his 6th year as the Keydets Head Coach
- In 2006 he led UMC to 30 wins, the most in their history
- During his coaching career he has helped guide 23 players into the pro ranks
- In only 4 seasons he became the winningest coach in program history
- Marlin was a four year starting catcher for the Keydets
