

Frozen Rosters

Effective April 1, 2010

Any team finishing in the top 25% of an event will have their roster qualified and frozen. If a team is qualified, it will be indicated on the team's page in the USSSA National site. Roster remains frozen until end of season.

Frozen Rosters mean a player is restricted to playing for that team only unless they are released from the frozen roster team. Any player being released cannot return to that team for the remainder of the season. Teams with frozen rosters can add up to 3 players as long as those players are not on another frozen roster.

Players can appear on more than 1 frozen roster if the teams are in different age groups. However a player can only play in one event on a weekend.

New this year a team can release as many players as they wish but any qualified roster going below 9 players will be considered disbanded and give up any births they have earned and be required to start over as a new team. They will also be limited to 6 players from the old team.
